External Grant Review Funding

Faculty in Harris College can access up to \$500 in funding to support honorariums for external expert reviewers providing feedback on first- or senior-author manuscripts or grant applications. This funding aims to facilitate timely and valuable feedback before submission, increasing the likelihood of acceptance. To utilize this funding, faculty members must have a nearly finalized manuscript or grant application draft ready for review, and the faculty member should be the principal investigator for the grant application.

To apply for the funding, faculty members should complete the linked application. The application requires:

1. Product outlet (journal or grant-funding mechanism)
2. Brief explanation of how the review will advance the product
3. Suggested expert reviewer with their qualifications

It is not necessary for the reviewer to have confirmed their willingness to participate; the Associate Dean of Research will help the faculty member reach out and establish a review contract if needed.

For assistance in finding suitable reviewers, faculty members can contact the Associate Dean for Research at the e.lund@tcu.edu.

Applications for funding should be submitted through Irma Preciado at i.preciado@tcu.edu. The funding will be granted on a rolling basis. To allow for a timely external review, applicants are advised to submit their funding applications well in advance, considering a potential month-long period between the application and the completion of the external review.
