## **A History of Devotion**

The Harris College of Nursing & Health Sciences has been blessed with a number of strong contributors who have helped to establish and expand it over the years. One man demonstrated a unique sense of devotion to the school and the financial needs of its students. The Reverend Dr. W. W. Ward, a 25-year member of the Harris College of Nursing board of directors, made a lasting contribution through his efforts as scholarship chairman of the board.

# W. W. Ward Endowment Fund Policies and Information

#### Eligibility

Eligibility is limited to full-time nursing students enrolled in nursing at Texas Christian University. A FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) must be on file in the Texas Christian University Financial Aid office to be eligible for consideration.

#### **Employment Status**

If employed, the candidate may not be employed by a non-Texas Health Resources affiliated health care organization.

#### **Maximum Scholarship Amount**

Students may receive up to 1,000 a semester – fall, spring or summer. There is no lifetime maximum of funds one student may receive, as long as the student is eligible and reapplies each semester.

#### Grades

The student must maintain a grade point average of 2.5 or above to apply for scholarship funds for the next semester.

#### **Application Process**

Submit a completed application, by the appropriate due date, to TCU Nursing along with a typed essay which addresses the student's financial need, professional goals, current employment, if any, and any special situations which might influence the decision to award the scholarship.

#### **Evaluation Criteria**

Scholarship funds will be awarded in a non-discriminatory manner based upon an evaluation of the following criteria:

- 1. Financial need
- 2. Academic achievement
- 3. Employment preference (Texas Health Harris Methodist hospitals)
- 4. Classification (Jr. or Sr. level status)
